Path Development Proposals

The newly-formed Path Development Group has been established to progress a **Key Priority** in our **Community Action Plan (2011)**:

the development of safe walking (pavements) and cycling routes around our villages and connecting us to Loch Ardinning, Milngavie, Lennoxton, the West Highland Way and Killearn.

It starts with the following list of proposals. The upgrading of the walking/cycle path from Station Road to the Allotments entrance is the current priority, but we are keen to get your thoughts and suggestions on these proposals – and any additional ideas that you would like to have considered.

Project Proposals:

- 1 Upgrading the existing path on the old railway line to Station Road
- 2 Path refurbishment on the old railway line from Station Road to West Highland Way going west —for walkers and cyclists.
- 3 Footpath access from Strathblane to Loch Ardinning Nature Reserve.
- 4 Open access to the Campsies from the middle of the village.
5. Pavement/footpath creation or restoration: Campsie Road, A81 to West Ballewan; Station Road to Old Railway line; A81 up to Minister's Brae; Old Mugdock Road at hairpin bend at the top of the rise; Campsie Road from Kirk Rooms to Roundabout with crossing of A81 on the Milngavie side.
6. Path development — especially for cycling —to Milngavie going south.
