As Stirling Council seeks to divest itself of land and assets it has no further use for local communities will have the opportunity to take over responsibility for those which can continue to serve a valuable local purpose. Such a transfer is already in process for the Gravediggers' Bothy in the churchyard.

The next opportunity arises with the defunct toilets and the triangle of land on which they are sited. This piece of quite steeply loping land, in a central position opposite the War Memorial in Blanefield, is designated for 'garden use' only and there is significant support for a proposal that it could be used as a 'community orchard'.
